

Grant Opportunities

Challenged Athletes Foundation: <https://www.challengedathletes.org/grants/>

- **Eligibility:** Individuals worldwide with **permanent physical disabilities** are eligible to apply for the CAF grant. Teams, organizations, etc. are not eligible to apply. Medical documentation of disability is required.
- **Grant Request Options:** Applicants may request one of the following grant types: – Sports Expenses Grant – Equipment Grant – Ossur Prosthetic Grant
- **Application window:** Fall, (typically Sep-Nov) Year Round for Idaho residents and military/public protection veterans

- **Eligibility: Spinal Cord Injuries only.** Other conditions are not eligible for our grant programs, including (but not limited to) spina bifida, cerebral palsy, multiple sclerosis, post-polio, Guillain-Barre´ Strohl Syndrome, ALS, all other neuropathies, and all other conditions causing disability.
- **Grant Request Options:** Any piece of sports or recreation equipment specifically designed for people with disabilities that allow an applicant to be active.
- **Application window:** Spring (Typically Feb-March) Fall (Typically July-Sep)

- **Eligibility:** Only for SCI, TBI or life--changing injury while participating in **outdoor action sports** Skiing, snowboarding, ski BASE, ski mountaineering, ice climbing, Nordic skiing, kayaking, mountain biking, rock climbing, winged sports, hiking/trekking, trail running, etc. **No team sports**
- **Grant Request Options:** Adaptive sporting equipment
- **Application Window:**
 - 1: Jan 1- Jan 31 - Disabled Vets and Outdoor action sports injuries
 - Q2: March 31 - Outdoor action sports injuries
 - Q3: June 30 - Outdoor action sports injuries
 - Q4: September 1 - **All SCI, TBI, and other life changing disabilities as a result of injury**

- **Eligibility:** Any member of PossAbilities may apply based on the guidelines listed below. A friend or family member may also apply on behalf of a PossAbilities member, as long as the PossAbilities member is willing to sign a release of liability if selected to receive support.
- **Grant Request Options:** Equipment to improve quality of life. Accessibility grants (Not to exceed \$15,000). Educational scholarships (Not to exceed \$5,000). Travel to and/or participation in adaptive sporting events. Other needs specific to the disabled population
- **Application Window:** Typically June-Aug
